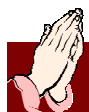

Welcome visitors! If you would like to register with one of our parishes, please introduce yourself to Father George and Deacon Greg and fill out a registration form located in the back of church. If you are already a member, please notify the Parish Office whenever there is a change in your name, address or phone number, or if someone moves into or out of your home (such as a baby being born, a young adult getting a place of their own, or a couple separating or divorcing. Young adults (age 21 and over) should register as a separate household even if they still live in their parents home. Also, newly married couples MUST fill out and return a registration form to be registered in the parish. Changes can be made by filling out a registration form to update your information; or by dropping a note in the weekend collection or emailing the parish office.
