Dear Faith Community,

As you know, we are always looking for volunteers for Children's Church, Vacation Bible School, and Religious Education, as well as events and activities planned throughout the year. A requirement of the Archdiocese is that all volunteers who have any contact with children and teens attend a Safe Environment Training class and have a criminal background check. The Safe Environment Training class is 2 hours long and not very difficult to get through. Once you have this training, you do not need to take it again unless directed to do so at some future date. Background checks must be updated every 5 years (contact Kathy Shacklett or myself to fill out an application for confidential background check through the Archdiocese.)
