This will take place on **Tuesday, September 20, 2022**, 6:00 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Assumption (433 South Fifth Street, Louisville). The pallium itself was blessed at a special Mass in the Vatican by His Holiness Pope Francis on June 29, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. 
