With a yes answer to that question, the online form provides a drop-down menu of parishes.

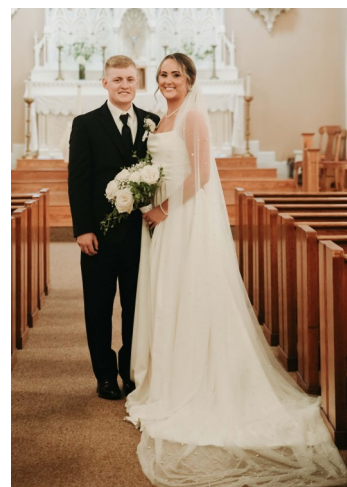
