Change in Distribution of Holy Communion

The previously recommended practice was to stand throughout the entire distribution of Holy Communion. While commendable, this is not the norm in most places and has led to some confusion and disunity. Therefore, the practice will be for the faithful to kneel after the Lamb of God and remain kneeling until joining the Communion procession. After receiving Holy Communion, the faithful return to their places and kneel, or sit if unable, for a period of thanksgiving and personal prayer. It is then appropriate for all to sit once the remaining Hosts have been returned to the tabernacle or taken out of the sanctuary to the place of reservation.

Mass Schedule Change

It's that time of year — Saturday evening mass will change to St. Theresa starting July 5th! Mass time will remain 6:00 pm. Due to St. Mary picnic on July 12, there will be no Saturday mass at St. Theresa that day. Mass will be at 4 pm at St. Mary.
