2025 Picnic Dedicated to Eddie Greenwell

This year the St. Mary picnic is dedicated to Lawrence Edward "Eddie" Greenwell. Eddie passed on October 31, 2024. He was a lifelong member of St. Mary's and a devout church goer. When Eddie started going to Florida about 15 years ago, one of the first things he did was find a nearby Catholic church so he could attend mass. Every year Eddie put up the entire sound system for the picnic and made sure it stayed operational during the event. When his boys, Mark and Mike, were young, he even put them to work teaching them the importance of stewardship and hard work. Eddie was also instrumental in putting up the first "Blessing Box" in the county. His son, Mike, read about it and took it to his dad and by the end of that day, Eddie had built the boxes. Today, more than 30 local churches have boxes and keep them maintained. Eddie's biggest achievement though are his six kids—Mark, Mike, Jayde, Tammy, Trish & Rhonda.
