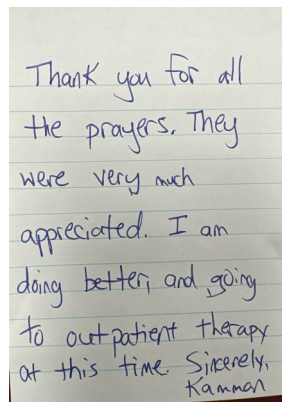
Prayer Intention for the Week
