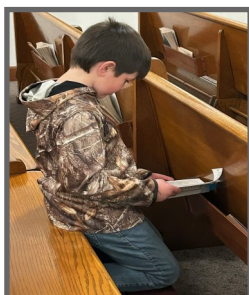
To the Parishioners of St. Mary and St. Theresa:

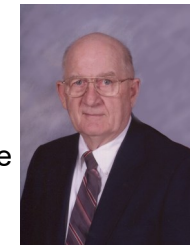
