2026 Black and Indian Mission Collection

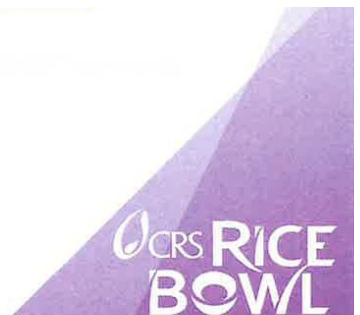
The weekend of February 21/22 we will take up the Black and Indian Mission Collection. This collection exists to help diocesan communities preach the Gospel of Jesus among African Americans, Native Americans, and Alaskan Natives. Your donations help fund parish-based catechetical programs, support teacher and catechist professional development, encourage vocations to the priesthood and religious life, and create diocesan structures, such as our own archdiocesan Office of Multicultural Ministry, that support ministry and evangelization in these diverse ethnic communities.

Scholarships for High School Seniors

For all high school seniors that are members of St. Mary and St. Theresa, we have two scholarship opportunities. One is a \$1,000 scholarship to one parishioner from each parish. The other is a \$500 Dereke Chism Scholarship from St. Mary's. Mr. Matt Spencer, MCHS Counselor, has all the necessary paperwork. If the student does not attend MCHS, please contact the parish office for all paperwork. All applications must be turned in by March 13th. If the recipients are MCHS students, the announcement will be made at the MCHS Awards Night later in the school year. If the recipients do not attend MCHS, we will personally contact them.

The CRS Rice Bowl is the Lenten program of Catholic Relief Services, the official relief and development agency of the US Conference of Catholic Bishops. The money goes to alleviate hunger and poverty in communities around the world and in the US.
