Mowing season has begun at both cemeteries. No benches, flower arrangements, statues, or any other objects are permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing or weedeating. Shepherds hooks are acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements don't interfere with mowing/weedeating. Small statues or any other objects placed on the base of the monument must be glued to the base so they don't end up on the ground. Please note when flower arrangements get blown off due to high winds, we have no way of knowing which grave they belong to. If there are any items on your loved ones monument you'd like to get before we start mowing, now is the time. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
