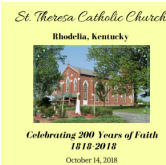

Parish Membership



Welcome visitors! If you would like to register with one of our parishes, please introduce yourself to Father George and Deacon Greg and fill out a registration form located in the back of church or download one from our website. If you are already a member, please notify the Parish Office whenever there is a change in your name, address or phone number, or if someone moves into or out of your home (such as a baby being born, a young adult getting a place of their own, or a couple separating or divorcing. Young adults (age 21 and over) should register as a separate household even if they still live in their parents home. Also, **newly married couples MUST** fill out and return a registration form to be registered in the parish. Changes can be made by filling out a registration form to update your information; or by dropping a note in the weekend collection or emailing the parish office.

Safe Environment Training

The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study or participate in church-sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY length of time are required to attend the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshop. If you plan to work with the Religious Ed. Program, RCIC, Children’s Church, Youth Ministry or any other program involving children and youth this year or in the future, you **MUST** attend this training at least once. It is advisable to arrive 15 minutes prior to workshop start time to complete paperwork. Attendees must remain present the entire 2 hour presentation and complete completion paperwork at the end. The next workshop available in our area is: **August 23 - 6:30 p.m.** - St. James in Elizabethtown, 307 West Dixie Avenue, Elizabethtown, KY 42701 in the gym at Batcheldor Hall.
