From Archbishop Kurtz

In a letter dated May 17, 2021 from Archbishop Kurtz, he stated that effective immediately any person who has received the final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at least two weeks prior is not required to wear a mask in worship services or other meetings at church. Those not vaccinated or not fully vaccinated are asked to continue to wear a mask as well as anyone else who wishes to wear one. Individuals and family groups are still asked to distance themselves at least 3 feet from other families or individuals.

Safe Environment Training

The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study or participate in church sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, **all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth** (18 and under) for ANY length of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops. **At this time, the trainings are limited to 50 individuals. All trainings are first come/first served. No advance registration is necessary.** The next scheduled are:
