If you are working with, or plan to work with, children & youth as a catechist, children's church teacher, youth volunteer or chaperone, teacher's aid, vacation bible school volunteer or in any other way. Safe Environment "Refresher" Training - Last November, Archbishop Kurtz sent out a letter announcing the new five year Safe Environment "Refresher" Training requirement. The refresher is for staff and volunteers who attended their initial Safe Environment training over 5 years prior and needs to be completed before the end of 2022. The refresher can be done online or at any of the scheduled in person trainings, only **AFTER** a member has completed an **initial IN PERSON** training.
