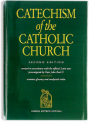

This will take place on **Tuesday, September 20, 2022**, 6:00 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Assumption (433 South Fifth Street, Louisville). The pallium itself was blessed at a special Mass in the Vatican by His Holiness Pope Francis on June 29, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. Permanent Diaconate Discernment

The Office of the Diaconate for the Archdiocese of Louisville is opening the application process for the 2028 cohort. Formation classes will begin in July of 2023. The application process typically takes a few months, including collection of paperwork (baptismal & marriage certificates), essays, and multiple interviews. We are starting with information and discernment sessions in September.
