**Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith; in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness....and not only to me, but also to all who have loved his appearing."* 2 Timothy 4:7-8

This message from St. Paul assures us that those who endure hardships and sacrifices, yet devote their lives to the service of God and others, will receive the crown of heaven. Stewards always place their trust in God.

**Amendment 2 on November 8 Ballot**

In matters of public policy that are not tied to either candidate or party, the Church is both legally permitted and duty bound to speak ...especially when those policies concern the dignity and sanctity of life.

On November 8<sup>th</sup>, Kentuckians will go to the polls once again. One of the choices facing them this year are two proposed amendments to our State Constitution. The second of these is of paramount importance, as it will explicitly affirm that the Kentucky Constitution contains no right to either abortion or its governmental funding.

The Kentucky Catholic Bishops are therefore strongly encouraging all Kentuckians to go to the polls on election day this year, turn over their ballots and vote 'YES' for Amendment #2 which is located at the very bottom of the back page. A "YES" vote on Amendment #2 is a vote for life!



**Safe Environment Training**

The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study or participate in church sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, **all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth** (18 and under) for ANY lengthy of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops. **All trainings are first come/first served.
